TIMOTHY SCHOLARSHIP

Timothy Scholarship Guidelines Purpose

The Timothy Scholarship (TS) was created by Hunterdon Christian Church to enable children of its members, encouraging and supporting them, in pursuing the ministry in a post high school education. (See "Eligibility" below for more complete information).

The TS addresses a number of concerns, primarily:

1. Many students training for ministry lack the financial resources to provide for post-high school education.
2. Many students incur debt to attend college.
3. Persons close to the ministry and the individual would like to help if they were made aware of the need and had a vehicle to assist.

Description

The Timothy Scholarship is a component fund of the Hunterdon Christian Church Missions. When a student applies to the Missions Committee, the committee reviews the candidate's qualifications for a scholarship. If the candidate is eligible, the committee then recommends the amount of the annual scholarship assistance.

Structure

The Mission Committee is selected by the Elder in charge and meets with them to review applications and makes recommendations as to;

- Number of scholarships (determined in the preceding year),
- New candidates for Timothy Scholarships,
- Annual scholarship amounts;
- Any changes in scholarship term, procedure, or policy.

Eligibility

Students may qualify for a scholarship for educational expenses. In order to be eligible for such a scholarship, the student must:

- Have the feeling of being led by God toward studies and desiring the office, duties, or functions of a minister, servant, or agent; ecclesiastical, executive, or ambassadorial function or profession earning a degree.
- Be a young man or woman of good character, and exemplify Christian morals; and
- In the opinion of the Committee, have the ability to succeed in their school of choice; and
- Be a member of HCC or a dependent child of a Hunterdon Christian Church member studying for ministry at the post-high school level; and
- Be attending, or planning to attend, a school full time; and
- Have the ability to pay for the balance of his or her education.

Application Process

- Submit Application to the Mission Committee by April 1st ,
- Be approved by the Missions Committee,
- Funds available approved,
- Attend the school of his or her choice; remain in good standing with the school.

Application Document

1) The Student Application consists of:

- Biographical information sheet,
- Letter of Testimony of faith in Jesus Christ,
- A Letter explaining why this Scholarship is important to you,
- An Essay describing applicants intentions with the degree sought.

The Missions Committee will periodically meet and review any applications that are submitted by April 1st for scholarship funds. Based on available funds the Missions Committee will decide on an annual scholarship amount for each student. The students and the school will be notified in writing of the scholarship amount for that year. The funds will be forwarded, in the institutions name, and be deposited in the individual students' account.
